

Havelock Grain Project Announcement – November 9th, 2022

Pro Cooperative is very excited to announce the expansion of our Havelock location. The plan is to add two 800,000+ bushel bins to the facility as well as 6 new topside conveyers and a reclaim conveyer and reclaim leg on the north side of the existing silos in Havelock. Pro's Havelock location is a key component in the shipment of grain out of Pro Cooperative to other end users across North America. With the Pro Cooperative team loading numerous corn and soybean trains out of Havelock, this addition to the company will help our team be safer and more efficient during the train loadout times. Have you noticed some dirt work being done on the west side of the office? That is planned to be the new driveway where grain trucks get probed before driving onto the scale by the office. This is to make the weighing in and out process more efficient. The project is projected to be completed before harvest 2023. Pro Cooperative is very excited for this new addition to the company!
