Any suspected gas leak, even without an odor detected, **requires immediate emergency action.** Ignoring a suspected leak or a gas odor can result in a flash fire or explosion causing serious injury or death.

Give the caller these instructions and then collect the information below:

- **GET EVERYONE OUT OF THE HOUSE.** Immediately evacuate the residence/building without hanging up the phone, turning off/on light switches, appliance motors, or anything else that could create a spark.
- We will dispatch a service technician immediately and if needed we will notify local emergency personnel.
- Instruct caller to move to a safe area and keep all persons away from the leak area until emergency service personnel arrive on-site, and the area has been determined to be safe.
- Once everyone is outside the house, shut the tank or cylinder valves **only if it can be done safely.**
- Do not allow anyone except qualified gas professionals or fire department personnel to enter the home until a complete inspection can verify the dwelling is safe to enter.
- **Do not re-enter the area** until a trained service person or the fire department advises it is safe to do so.

Do not try to judge for yourself the level of danger of a gas leak by trying to determine if the smell of gas is weak or strong. All gas leaks pose a serious threat. A combustible mixture of propane may still be present even if no gassy odor is detected.
